RESPONDENT'S ANSWER TO PETITION FOR DIVORCE
AND
RESPONDENT'S CROSS-PETITION FOR DIVORCE

NOW COMES the Respondent, Gordon J. MacDonald, by and through his attorneys, TENN AND TENN, P.A., and submits this Answer to Petition for Divorce and Respondent's Cross-Petition for Divorce and, in correspondingly numbered paragraphs, states as follows:

1. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 1 of the Petition for Divorce ("Petition").
2. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 2 of the Petition, except that the Hancock address is a temporary address.
3. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 3 of the Petition.
4. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 4 of the Petition.
5. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 5 of the Petition.
6. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 6 of the Petition, except as to the June 8, 2019 date.
7. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 7 of the Petition.
8. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 8 of the Petition.
9. No response is required to Paragraph 9 of the Petition as that Paragraph is blank.
10. No response is required to Paragraph 10 of the Petition as that Paragraph is blank.
11. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 11 of the Petition.
12. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 12 of the Petition.

13. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 13 of the Petition.

14. The Respondent admits the allegations set forth in Paragraph 14 of the Petition to the extent that irreconcilable differences have developed that have caused the irremediable breakdown of the marriage, but Respondent otherwise denies the remaining allegations of Paragraph 14.

15. Paragraph 15 of the Petition sets forth Petitioner's requested relief and no answer is required here as those requests do not allege facts requiring an answer.

AND, IN FURTHER ANSWERING, the Respondent, Gordon J. MacDonald, states by way of Cross-Petition for Divorce the following:

16. The parties were lawfully married on May 20, 2006 in Hillsborough, New Hampshire.

17. Gordon J. MacDonald has continuously resided in New Hampshire for more than one year.

18. The Petitioner, Jennifer A. Eber, resides at 128 Dickey Hill Road, Deering, County of Hillsborough, State of New Hampshire 03244. Her date of birth is [REDACTED], 1966.

19. The Respondent, Gordon J. MacDonald maintains his permanent residence at 128 Dickey Hill Road, Deering, County of Hillsborough, State of New Hampshire, 03244 and is presently living at a temporary address of 30 Norway Hill Road, Hancock, County of Hillsborough, State of New Hampshire 03449. His date of birth is [REDACTED], 1961.

20. One child has been born to the parties during this marriage, namely: Nellie MacDonald (date of birth [REDACTED], 2008).

B. Order that the real estate, personal property, financial, retirement and other assets of the parties be equitably divided between them;


C. Make appropriate orders regarding decision-making and residential responsibility and parenting time for the minor child;




