Both counsel appeared for a telephonic conference with the Court, this date. Both parties were excused by agreement.



11 THE COURT: Okay.

13 something to you.

14 THE COURT: Okay. That sounds fine from our
15 standpoint. I'm glad to hear that that progress is being made
16 and happy to schedule it out for further status and check in
17 with you then. And hopefully by that point, things will be
18 either coming together in earnest or maybe already done. So
19 that's great news and happy to -- happy to hear it.

20 Anything further we need to accomplish today?

21 MR. TENN: No, Your Honor.

22 MS. REIS: No, I don't believe so, Judge.

23 THE COURT: Okay. All right. Well, thank you both
24 for calling in. I appreciate the update, and I'll look
25 forward to speaking with you in about 60 days.

1 MR. TENN: Great. Thank you.

2 THE COURT: Thanks so much.

3 MS. REIS: Thank you, Your Honor.

4 THE COURT: Thank you so much. Bye-bye.

5 MR. TENN: Have a nice rest of the summer,
6 everybody.
